The Fine Print

- All shows start promptly at 8:30 am, rain or shine.
- A separate entry form is required for each horse/exhibitor combination and a separate number is required for each horse/exhibitor or pony/exhibitor combination. DRC members will be assigned numbers at the beginning of their show season. Numbers can be reserved on request, on a first come/first served basis. Email cathyglover@telus.net to reserve your number.
- Stalls may be reserved for horses only in advance only when payment accompanies reservation on a first come/first served basis at \$15 per day. Tack stalls not available.
- There is no post-entry fee, however entries may be dropped off at Roddicks or the Dog & Pony no later than Friday 5 pm before the show. Dressage entries may also be dropped off, but no later than the Sunday before the show.
- Exhibitors are responsible for familiarizing themselves with club rules and class descriptions before the show. Class descriptions are available on the website at www.deltaridingclub.com or in the show office.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to order their log books for BC Heritage qualifying shows from hcbc.ca prior to the show. Applications will be available in the office.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Stallions can only be shown by senior exhibitors, 19 and over.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. Classes may be run concurrently at show manager's discretion.
- Proper attire is required** for all shows. All exhibitors must wear boots with heels when mounted.
- All exhibitors are encouraged to wear ASTM-approved helmets. ASTM-approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors riding over fences. ASTM-approved helmets must be worn by all youth English exhibitors. Western exhibitors will not be penalized for wearing helmets.
- Lead Line classes are restricted to riders 10 years and under and will start at approx. 10 am when offered. Handlers must be 12 years and over. Exhibitors may only cross enter in Showmanship and Halter classes.
- Walk/Trot entries may only cross-enter into Showmanship, Halter and In-Hand Trail classes.
- Novice classes: open to riders who have not won more than three firsts in that class at any show any where.
- All cross rail entries must be received by 8 am or the division will be cancelled and the show will start at 8:30 am with the 2' division.
- Coaching from the sidelines is NOT permitted.** Coaching may result in an exhibitor being eliminated from the class.
- Exhibitors for each class must be ready at the in-gate and report to the whipper in prior to their class.** Gate holds (maximum five minutes) will be allowed only if whipper-in is notified in advance. Announcement will be made. A 10 minute break will be provided after English and Western halter classes. Lunch break will be announced at the discretion of show management.
- The decision of the judge regarding the placing of contestants is final. Questions to the judge on other matters must be placed through the Show Manager after the show.
- All complaints must be referred immediately to the Show Manager.
- Regardless of all else, Delta Riding Club rules will supersede any other rules that may apply to any given show or event at the Delta Riding Club.
- No cantering or galloping of horses or ponies outside of rings.
- Rosettes are presented to first thru sixth place in all classes.
- High point awards are given at each show.
