

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ...

1. All EW & HJ shows start promptly at 8:30 am, rain or shine. Games Day starts at 9 am.
2. A separate entry form is required for each horse/exhibitor combination and a separate number is required for each horse/exhibitor or pony/exhibitor combination. DRC members will be assigned numbers at the beginning of their show season. Numbers can be reserved on request, on a first come/first served basis.
3. Stalls may be reserved in advance only when payment accompanies reservation on a first come/first served basis at \$10 per day.
4. There is no post-entry fee, however pre-entry exhibitors will be entered in a draw. Entries may be dropped off at Roddicks or the Dog & Pony no later than Friday 5 pm before the show.
5. Most shows are BC Heritage qualifying shows. Exhibitors are encouraged to apply to the Horse Council of BC for their English and Western log books prior to the show, however, applications will be available in the entry office. See [www.hcbc.ca] for more information.
6. Shows follow Equine Canada [www.equinecanada.ca] rules with some exceptions. Class descriptions are available on the website [www.deltaridingclub.com] or in the show office.
7. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
8. Stallions can only be shown by senior exhibitors, 19 and over.
9. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. Classes may be run concurrently at show manager's discretion.
10. Proper attire is required for all shows (ie no tank tops). All exhibitors must wear boots with heels when mounted.
11. All exhibitors are encouraged to wear ASTM-approved helmets. ASTM-approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors riding over fences. ASTM-approved helmets must be worn by all youth English exhibitors. Western exhibitors will not be penalized for wearing helmets.
12. Lead Line classes are restricted to riders 10 years and under and will start at approx. 10 am when offered. Handlers must be 12 years and over. Exhibitors may only cross enter in Showmanship, Halter and Turnout classes.
13. Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot Individual Canter entries may only cross-enter into Showmanship, Halter, Turnout and In-Hand Trail classes.
14. Entries in Draft classes must be full Draft (of a recognized breed); half draft horses are ineligible for these classes. Proof of registration may be required.
15. Hunter division classes will run concurrently with warm up rounds. Training aids and hors concor entries (entry will not be judged) will be allowed in classes, with the exception of BC Heritage qualifying classes.
16. Warm-up rounds will run before the first "over fence" class of each division and before the Jumper classes. Tickets will be provided by the entry office upon payment of fee and redeemed to the whipper in.
17. All cross rail entries must be received by 8 am or the division will be cancelled and the show will start at 8:30 am with the 2' division.
18. Games Day only: Running Martingales with stoppers are allowed. Standing martingales and tie downs are not allowed. Horses may be shown in English or Western tack.
19. No coaching from the sidelines will be allowed. Coaching may result in an exhibitor being eliminated from the class.
20. Contestants for each class must be ready at the in-gate and report to the whipper in prior to their class. Gate holds (maximum five minutes) will be allowed only if whipper-in is notified in advance. Announcement will be made. A 10 minute break will be provided after English and Western halter classes. Lunch break will be announced at the discretion of show management.
21. The decision of the judge regarding the placing of contestants is final. Questions to the judge on other matters must be placed through the Show Manager after the show.
22. All complaints must be referred immediately to the Show Manager.
23. No cantering or galloping of horses or ponies outside of rings.
24. Ribbons are presented to first thru sixth place in all classes.
25. High point awards are given at each show.

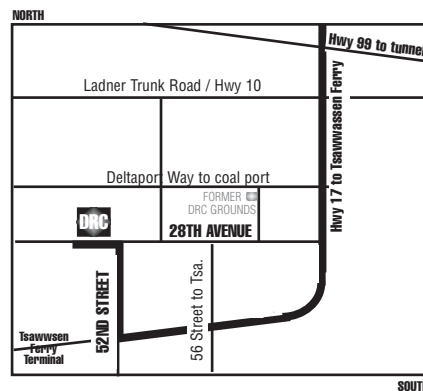
