

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ...

1. All Entries must be on the DRC SUMMER CLASSIC entry form. Pre-entries may be mailed to: Delta Riding Club, PO Box 1185, Delta, BC V4M 3T3 or dropped off at the Dog & Pony or Roddick's Farm & Feed Supply and received by **August 4**.
2. A separate SUMMER CLASSIC entry form (available to download from www.deltaridingclub.com) is required for each horse/rider combination. Each horse/rider must have their own number.
3. Stalls may be reserved in advance only when payment accompanies reservation on a first come/first served basis at \$15 per day.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for familiarizing themselves with club rules and class descriptions before the show. Class descriptions are available on the website at [www.deltaridingclub.com] or in the show office. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
5. Prior to closing date, all fees will be refunded. After closing date, 50% of entry fees will be refunded only with a veterinarian's certificate presented within 24 hours of the show.
6. In the case of the rider being disabled, equitation class fees only will be refunded upon presentation of a doctor's certificate.
7. Numbers will NOT be given to competitors who have outstanding balances for their show entries. When picking up numbers, competitors are required to pay *cash* for outstanding amounts (i.e. miscalculations, NSF cheque replacement and fee, post entry fees, etc).
8. Stallions can only be shown by senior exhibitors, 19 and over.
9. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. Classes may be run concurrently at show manager's discretion.
10. **Proper attire is required** (ie coats in English). All exhibitors must wear boots with heels when mounted.
11. All exhibitors are encouraged to wear ASTM-approved helmets. ASTM-approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors riding over fences. ASTM-approved helmets must be worn by all youth English exhibitors. Western exhibitors will not be penalized for wearing helmets.
12. Lead Line classes are restricted to riders 10 years and under and will start at approx. 10 am. Handlers must be 12 years and over. Exhibitors may only cross enter in Showmanship, Halter and In-Hand Trail classes.
13. Walk/Trot entries may only cross-enter into Showmanship, Halter and In-Hand Trail classes.
14. All cross rail entries must be received by 8 am or the division will be cancelled and the show will start at 8:30 am with the 2' division.
15. **No coaching from the sidelines will be allowed.** Coaching may result in an exhibitor being eliminated from the class.
16. To be eligible for the Stake class, the exhibitor must have entered at least one class in the respective division: (If entering English Pleasure Open Stake, for example, entry must have shown in an English Pleasure age division class.)
17. **Contestants for each class must be ready at the in-gate and report to the whipper in prior to their class.** Gate holds (maximum five minutes) will be allowed only if whipper-in is notified in advance. Announcement will be made. A 10 minute break will be provided after English and Western halter classes. Lunch break will be announced at the discretion of show management.
18. The decision of the judge regarding the placing of contestants is final. Questions to the judge on other matters must be placed through the Show Manager after the show.
19. All complaints must be referred immediately to the Show Manager.
20. No cantering or galloping of horses or ponies outside of rings.
21. Rosettes presented to first thru sixth place in all classes.

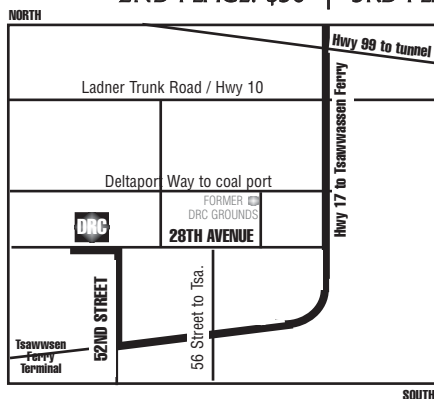
