### SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 27

#### "WILD & WOOLY" with Adiva Murphy, 9 am til noon

Join this gifted natural horsemanship trainer and coach for this 3 hour session that includes an hour of groundwork (to get out the "play" before we ride) focussing on basic exercises on the ground will help horse owners of every persuasion cope with energetic, playful horses. Once mounted you will work on suppling, review your emergency stop and work on tempo and rail work. Adiva has been a presenter at the Mane Event in Chilliwack and Red Deer and has presented clinics throughout BC and Alberta. She has a wonderful ability to take the complicated concepts of natural horsemanship and break them down in to clear, simple, straight forward steps that any horse owner can follow. Her clinics are friendly and fun, and the results are amazing. Whether you have worked with Adiva in the past, or this will be your first meeting, this clinic will get you and your horse off to a great start this spring! #### DRESSAGE with Kiersten Humphrey

It's a real privilege to have a coach of this calibre come to Delta Riding Club this spring. Kiersten Humphrey is an Equine Canada Level II coach and a successful FEI level rider who has ridden with the renowned Dietrich VonHopfgarten and currently rides with Leslie Reid. Her students credit her for allowing them to reach their goal of riding at the FEI level. "Every time someone goes into the ring to learn from her," writes one, "they walk out better than they came in." Whether your goals are "humble or grand," Kiersten will help you and your steed ramp it up a notch in dressage! We are booking four 45 minute semi-private lessons with Kiersten, from 1 pm til 4. ### SATURDAY, MARCH 27

#### GENERAL PERFORMANCE 101 with Jenny Leibenzeder, 9 am til noon

Whether you're new to the show ring, or even if you've got some miles under your belt, here's the clinic that *inspired this series!* You come to our shows, you enter every class you can, but do you *REALLY* understand the (subtle) differences between Basic Seat and Hunt Seat? How about English Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle? Road Hack and Show Hack?

Trainer and coach Jenny Leibenzeder has done it all -- and done it well! And by the end of this three hour session, you will be more prepared than ever to strut your stuff in the show ring! Jenny will put you on the rail and give you a chance to ride in a "show ring" environment with other "exhibitors," assess your riding, your horse and your suitability to the class -- and what you can do to ramp it up a notch. Jenny has trained horses of all breeds and coached riders of all ages to many over-all titles including championships at the provincial and national levels in all disciplines. Class limit, 8 riders. #### "TRAIL TRICKS & TIPS" with Melissa Buckley, 1 til 4 pm

Trail and Handy Horse classes are back at DRC and whether you're an old hand (in need of a tune-up) or are going to ride these classes for the first time this year, Paint and Quarter Horse trainer Melissa Buckley will set you and Trigger up for success! Melissa is a two time reserve world champion/world champion top ten trainer in ABRA (American Buckskin Registry Assoc) and has won and coached riders to national championships in multiple events including many all around and circuit awards in APHA, PtHA, PBHA and AQHA. She has consistently led "in-hand" trail futurity winners here in BC and across the line and is looking forward to helping our members learn to successfully navigate the obstacles they can expect to find in their trail and handy horse -- and even in-hand -- classes! ### SATURDAY, APRIL 10

#### "PERFECT PATTERNS" with Jodie Moore, 9 am til noon

Few moments can be as nerve wracking as those before entering a pattern class at a show. Whether it's basic seat or hunt seat equitation, horsemanship or showmanship, knowing what to expect and how (and when) to cue your horse to execute the perfect pattern will set you up for success this show season. Pattern classes are the true test of horsemanship and in this clinic, trainer, coach and judge Jodie Moore will walk you through the exercises you need to practice to master your pattern classes. We'll spend an hour or so on the ground with showmanship, then mount up. Jodie, alongside husband Chris Moore, specializes in coaching amateur and youth riders and together they have trained and coached an impressive list of APHA and PtHA top ten, reserve and world champions. Jodie also carries judges cards for both PtHA and HCBC. This class will be suitable for both English and Western riders. Class limit, 10 riders. No rain date.

#### "IMPROVE YOUR RIDE" with Adiva Murphy, 1 til 4 pm

Kim presents her approach to riding hunters and hunt seat equitation with insightful enthusiasm. She believes that riding well is a matter of mastering the basics; a rider with a solid foundation is capable of effectively communicating with their horse. Kim teaches the principles of quality hunt seat riding with a focus on perfect equitation, both on the flat and over fences. Focus on the "ideal" helps riders succeed in the showing and enjoy the ride along the way. Join Kim for a 90 minute introductory session. No prior jumping experience is required. Participants will be grouped according to their and their horses ability and experience. As a junior rider in the 70's and early 80's, Kim competed on the A-circuit in Hunters, Jumpers, and Equitation, winning numerous championships including multiple equitation medals. Kim's expertise includes starting youngsters and training/conditioning competitors (horses as well as riders). In addition to her day job, Kim holds her USEF 'Pro'-card and assists Lindy Townley in preparing her clients at Westwind Equestrian for success on the A-circuit.
