Show Notes

Trot-Pole division is for new-to-showing riders only.

Riders who show in the trot-pole division may cross-enter into the cross-rail division.

Warm-up rounds are not judged. Jumper tack/attire permitted in warm-up rounds.

Coaching permitted during warm-up rounds.

Horses may compete in a maximum of two divisions.

Oxers in 2'3" and 2'6" divisions only.

PRE-ENTRY REQUIRED

- You MUST clearly indicate on your entry the test(s) you will be riding; for example:
 - HCBC Western W/J, Test 2
 - EC Second Level, Test 2
 - WDAC Intro Level, Test 3
- Please indicate the trainer or group with whom you would like to ride on your form
- Late entries accepted subject to space and availability; all late entries subject to a late fee of \$10.00/test.
- Submit entries online only

RIDE TIMES

Emailed to competitors on Friday prior to the show.

Show Notes

All tests are held in a 20 x 60m arena.

Tests may be ridden more than once, however only the first ride will count for year-end and/or daily high-score awards.

Daily high-point awards for both English and Western divisions.

Please enter no later than the Sunday prior to the show date.

HORSE SHOW RULES

1. Shows start promptly at 9:00am rain or shine.
2. Ages: A Junior competitor is 13 years of age or under as of January 1; Intermediate Competitor is 14-18 years of age as of January 1; Senior Competitor is 19 years of age or older as of January 1.
3. A separate entry form and competitor number is required for each horse/exhibitor combination.
4. Stalls are limited and available on a first-come-first-served basis. If you wish to reserve stalls you may do so by indicating this on your entry form and paying the deposit.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for familiarizing themselves with Club rules and class descriptions prior to the show. Class descriptions and rules are posted on the DRC website and in the Clubhouse.
6. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Numbers will NOT be given to competitors with outstanding balances.
7. Stallions handled ONLY by those aged 19 years and are NOT permitted in any walk/trot or walk/jog classes.
8. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes. Classes may run concurrently at the Show Manager's discretion.
9. Proper attire is required for all shows; refer to class descriptions for more information. Exhibitors MUST wear boots with a heel when mounted.
10. All exhibitors are encouraged to wear ASTM approved helmets.
- ASTM approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors riding in English classes and all Youth exhibitors. Western exhibitors are strongly encouraged to wear protective headgear.
11. Lead Line classes are restricted to riders aged 10 and under. Lead Line participants may only cross enter in showmanship, halter and in-hand trail classes.
12. Coaching from the sidelines is NOT permitted EXCEPT during hunter warm-up rounds. Coaching may result in the exhibitor being eliminated from the class.
13. Exhibitors must be ready at the in-gate and report to the whipper-in prior to their classes. Gate holds of up to five minutes will be permitted only if the whipper-in is notified in advance. A 15-minute break is provided after English and Western Showmanship classes so competitors may tack up their horses. In the event there are no showmanship entries, class #2 will start promptly at 9:00am. A 30-minute lunch break - and other breaks as warranted - will be held at the discretion of the Show Manager.
14. The decision of the judge regarding class placings is final. Any competitor wishing to speak with the judge must make a request to the Show Manager after the show.
15. Delta Riding Club rules will supersede any other rules for any show or event hosted by the Delta Riding Club.
16. No cantering, galloping, or loping permitted outside of rings.
17. Rosettes are presented to first through sixth place.
18. High-Point and Reserve High-Point awards are offered at each show.
