

The Fine Print

1. Entries must be received by Saturday, August 2 and may be dropped off at Westway Feeds or submitted online at www.deltaridingclub.com under the SHOWS tab.
2. The Show will start promptly at 8:00 am rain or shine. Gates will be open at 6:30 am.
3. A separate entry form and competitor number is required for each horse/exhibitor combination.
4. Due to limited stalls, tack stalls are not available. Please book your stall with your entry.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for familiarizing themselves with Club Rules and class descriptions prior to the show. Class descriptions can be found on the DRC website and in the Clubhouse.
6. Exhibitors participating in the BC Heritage program or the APHA PAC must present their forms in the entry office prior to showing.
7. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
8. Numbers will NOT be given to competitors who have outstanding balances for their show entries.
9. Stallions can only be handled by senior exhibitors 19 years and over.
10. No cantering, galloping, or loping outside of rings.
11. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes at its discretion. Classes may be run concurrently at the Show Manager's discretion.
12. Proper attire and braiding or banding is required for Hunter and English Classes. Braids do not have to be removed prior to entering the western classes. Western exhibitors may show in chaps or show pants. All exhibitors must wear boots with a heel when mounted.
13. All exhibitors are encouraged to wear ASTM approved helmets. ASTM approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors riding over fences and by all English Youth exhibitors. Western exhibitors are also encouraged to wear protective headgear.
14. The main arena will be available for Hunter warm up from 7am until the end of the 2'6" division. There will be no warm up rounds in the show ring.
15. Walk/Trot entries may only cross enter in Showmanship
16. Stake Class entry fee of \$20 is not included in day rates. The entry money will be split as follows: 1st place 50%, 2nd place 30%, 3rd place 20%. You must compete in at least three regular English or Western classes to qualify for the Stakes classes.
17. Coaching from the sidelines is NOT permitted. Coaching may result in an exhibitor being eliminated from the class.
18. Exhibitors for each class must be ready at the in-gate and report to the whipper-in prior to their class. Gate holds (maximum five minutes) will be allowed only if the whipper-in is notified in advance. A 30 minute lunch break will follow the hunter classes. There will be a break between English and Western including a tack break following Showmanship.
19. The decision of the judge regarding the placement of competitors is final. Any competitor wishing to speak with the judge must make a request to the show manager after the show.
20. Regardless of all else, Delta Riding Club rules will supersede any other rules that may apply to any given show or event at the Delta Riding Club.
21. **No refunds for scratched classes.** Classes may be added to an existing exhibitor at the regular rate on the day of the show. Post entries will pay a late fee of \$5 per class up to \$20 per exhibitor.
22. Rosettes are presented to first through sixth place. \$10 DRC "Bucks Back" coupons will be awarded to first place winners in all classes except Stakes Classes.
23. High Point and Reserve High Point awards are given for each Hunter Division, English Open, English Walk/Trot, and Western.

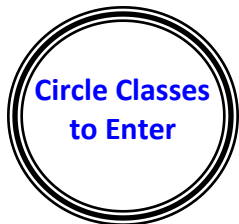
